a)	<p><b>Keysbrook Operational Update – Jordeana Cain</b>            The Operations update presentation was tabled and discussed including the following key points since 1 February 2023 meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mining remains on Lot 57, preparations planned for Lot 63 when approved</li> <li>• Remnant mining planned for Lot 62</li> <li>• Planned mining north of Elliott Road, Lot 56, deferred</li> <li>• Topsoil replacement and profile campaign planned for October</li> <li>• Lot 201, Elliott Road, to settle late August</li> <li>• Winter rains continues to challenge the operations</li> <li>• Dust suppression seeding confirmed ahead of summer months</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Keysbrook Extension</u></b>  <b>Western Extension includes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parallel environmental studies for Lots 507, 508, 201, 64 (Lots 62 and 20 Doral owned, Lot 201 Under Offer by Doral)</li> <li>• Lot 64 and Lot 507 subject to landholder consent</li> <li>• Anticipate ARI submission to EPA in August / September, likely 2 year approval process</li> <li>• Shire of SJ and Shire of Murray Development Application / EIL to be submitted when EPA approvals received</li> <li>• Current mine life ~ 2 to 2.5 years, including Lot 63 (4 – 5 years)</li> <li>• Stakeholder engagement advising of extension, no comments received to date</li> <li>• Northern extension requires crossing of Elliott Road, Traffic management plan to be prepared</li> </ul>
